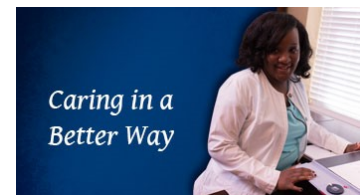

## H.R.C. Four Part Mission

### Community Involvement
